LARGE TREES (APPROX. 50+FT)


- Afghan Pine (*Pinus eldarica*) 1 drop
- Chinquapin Oak (*Quercus muhlenbergii*) 2 drops
- Common Hackberry (*Celtis occidentalis*) 2 drops
- Lacebark Elm (*Ulmus parvifolia*) 2 drops
- Southern Live Oak (*Quercus virginiana*) 1 drop

MEDIUM TREES (APPROX. 30-50FT)

- Chinese Pistache (*Pistacia chinensis*) 2 drops
- Honey Mesquite (*Neltuma glauca*) 1 drop
- Mexican Sycamore (*Platanus mexicana*) 2 drops
- Escarpment Live Oak (*Quercus fusiformis*) 2 drops
- Frontier Elm (*Ulmus 'Frontier'*) 2 drops

SMALL TREES (LESS THAN 30FT)

- Redbud (*Cercis canadensis 'Pink Pom Poms'*) 2 drops
- Desert Willow (*Chilopsis linearis*) 1 drop
- Golden Rain Tree (*Koelreuteria paniculata*) 2 drops
- Screwbean Mesquite (*Strombocarpa pubescens*) 2 drops
- Mexican Elderberry (*Sambucus mexicana*) 2 drops
